

LIQUOR ORDINANCE No. 86-2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 5 OF BUSINESS REGULATIONS OF ORDINANCE 101 PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TURTLE LAKE, NORTH DAKOTA, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 5-0401, Article 4, Chapter 5 of Ordinance No. 101 shall be amended as follows:

7) "Club" or "lodge" shall include any corporation or association organized for civic, fraternal, social or business purposes, or the promotion of sports, which has at least 50 members at the time of application for license and which was in existence on November 3, 1936.

11) "Wine" shall mean the alcoholic beverage obtained by fermentation of agricultural products containing natural or added sugar or such beverage fortified with brandy and containing not more than twenty-four per cent (24%) alcohol by volume.

Section 2. That Section 5-0405, Article 4, Chapter 5 of Ordinance No. 101, shall be amended as follows:

1) On- and off-sale liquor licenses at an annual fee of \$1,250.00 dollars.

2) Off-sale liquor license at an annual fee of \$675.00 dollars.

3) On- and off-sale beer license at an annual fee of \$150.00 dollars.

4) Off-sale beer license at an annual fee of \$75.00 dollars.

5) On-sale beer license at an annual fee of \$75.00 dollars.

6) On-sale club liquor and beer license at an annual fee of \$25.00 dollars.

7) On-sale wine license at an annual fee of \$75.00 dollars.

a) On sale beer and wine licenses as provided above shall be issued only if the applicants operate a restaurant in connection with the licenses and shall be renewed only upon showing that the gross revenue from food sales is larger than the gross revenue from beer and liquor sales.

Section 3: That Section 5-0411, Article 4, Chapter 5 of Ordinance No. 101 shall be amended to read as follows:

5.0411 License - Limit of Number.

- A. Two (2) on-sale and off-sale liquor retail.
- B. One (1) off-sale liquor retail.
- C. Two (2) on-sale and off-sale beer retail
- D. One (1) off-sale beer retail
- E. One (1) on-sale beer retail.
- F. One (1) on-sale club liquor and beer retail.
- G. One (1) on-sale wine retail.

SECTION 4. That Section 5-0416 Article 4 of Chapter 5 of Ordinance 101 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 5-0416 Hours and Time of Sale

1. Intoxicating liquor may be sold on the licensed premises between the hours of 8:00 a.m. one day until 12:45 a.m the following day, except Sundays after 12:45 a.m., days when sales are prohibited by State Law, and Election days between 12:45 a.m. and one hour after the polls have been closed. Those premises licensed with on-sale beer and on-sale wine licenses only may begin to sell intoxicating liquor only after 5:00 p.m.
2. Sales of liquor shall cease at 12:45 a.m. and 15 minutes thereafter shall be permitted for customers to consume such liquor as they have purchased before the hour of 12:45 a.m. All customers must leave the premises by the hour of 1:00 a.m.
3. Between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. of each day the doors of the establishment must be locked, provided, however, that the licensee and his employees may be permitted to enter upon the premises during such time, but no sales of liquor shall be made and no person other than the licensee and his employees may enter during said time.

SECTION 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in so far as the conflicting portions thereof are concerned.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect and will be in full force effective upon date of passage.
