

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING CONSECUTIVE PARKING AND REGULATING THE PARKING OF UNATTACHED TRAILERS WITHIN THE CITY OF TURTLE LAKE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TURTLE LAKE, NORTH DAKOTA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking Consecutively for over 96 hours - Prohibited

It shall be unlawful for any one to park or leave standing on any public street or highway in the city any vehicle for a period longer than ninety-six (96) hours consecutively, provided this section shall not include any area where a shorter time is provided for parking, nor shall this section be construed to permit parking for a longer time than is provided in such areas.

Any vehicle in violation of ordinance that is left unmoved for more than ninety-six (96) hours would be subject to a fine of ten dollars (\$10.00) If same vehicle is let unmoved for an additional twenty-four hours it could be towed away at the city's discretion and at the expense of the owner.

Section 2. Unattached Trailers Prohibited on Public Streets

It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave standing on any public street of the City any semi or full trailer unless attached to the tractor or tractor chassis used to pull it.

Nor shall any trailer, boat or snowmobile be parked or left standing on any public street except for emergency or temporary stopping or parking, and then only be permitted on any street, alley or highway for no longer than ninety-six (96) hours subject to any other or further traffic or parking limits imposed on such streets, alleys, or highways.

Section 3. Penalty

Any Vehicle in violation of ordinance would be subject to a fine of ten dollars (\$10.00). If same vehicle is left unmoved for additional twenty-four hours it could be towed away at the City's discretion and ~~exp~~ expense of the owner.

Section 4. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect and will be in full force upon date of passage.



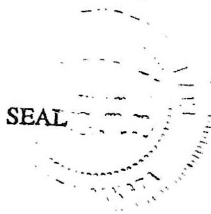
