

## CHAPTER XII

### FIREWORKS AND LIKE EXPLOSIVES

#### 12.0101 Sale Of

It shall be unlawful in the City of Turtle Lake to sell or offer for sale, use or set off, any firecrackers, fireworks, or like explosives except during the period beginning June 27th and ending July 5th, both dates inclusive, or except at such times and at such places as the Mayor of the city may expressly authorize and direct by proclamation. This prohibition shall extend to all types of fireworks, including those exempted from the provisions of Chapter 23-15 of the 1947 Supplement to the North Dakota Revised Code of 1943, but does not prohibit the use of fireworks by airplanes, railroads, or other transportation agencies for signal purposes of illumination or the sale or use of blank cartridges for a show or theatre, or for signal or ceremonial purposes in athletics or sports, or for use by military organizations.

However, it will be illegal to discharge fireworks at any time in any street or alleys in the City of Turtle Lake. Fireworks may be discharged on private properties and residences on the above days designated.

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Fifty Dollars and shall stand committed until such fine and taxable costs are paid.
